Emergency Pack: Each child will be asked to bring a one-gallon zip-lock bag filled with food and drinks to be placed in the child's classroom. Items that are recommended are:

- 2-Bottles of water or juice boxes
- 4-Granola bars or nutrition bars
- 2-Cheese crackers
- 1-Small game
- Letter or note from parents

Unused food will be eaten at the end of the year. Check the shelf life of the items you place in the pack to make sure they will survive nine months. Fill the bag with as much food as you can. Write the date, your child's name, and teacher's name on the pack outside of the pack.
